"The Amici degli Uffizi was founded in Florence in July 1993 to offer a civil response to the tragic bombing that severely damaged the Uffizi Gallery and several of its outstanding artworks. Since then, it has actively supported the Uffizi Gallery as a reference point and a trait d'union between contributors to the reconstruction, enhancement, and development of the Gallery and the museum authorities, who in this manner can count on the immediately available funding. The Amici degli Uffizi is an independent non-profit association."

This membership card provides unlimited access to the following state museums:

Students are required to bring this card to **every site visit for their classes**. If they fail to bring their card on the day of a site visit or lose the card, they will be required to pay for their own entrance ticket to the museum. If their card is stolen, or if they have any questions about this card, please send them to Anne Spyropoulos in the Office of Academic Support in Villa Ulivi.

Each card is personalized and can only be used by the person listed on the card. It is not transferable. (i.e.: Students cannot lend this card to their roommates or a friends!) Museums will ask for a second form of ID as proof of identification.
